Is It Okay Game. Play in a group of 4. Cut up the cards and place them face down in a pile on the table. Players take turns. Player 1 takes a card and must make a complete sentence using the words on the card. The other players check English Clip 6 and say, “Yes, that’s correct!” or “No, that’s wrong. It’s ...” If player one is correct, he or she scores a point and places the card at the bottom of the pile. Player 2 takes a card, and so on ... Players can only look at the English Clip 6 paper when they are checking another player. It is much easier for the teacher to demonstrate.
